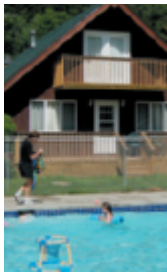

CANCELLATION POLICY FOR CABINS

Both cabins require 2-night minimum on weekends and 3 or 4-night minimum on holiday weekends. Reservations will be held with a 1-night deposit for regular weekends, and 2-3 night deposit for holiday weekends. Deposit is refundable with a 14-day notice. If cancellation occurs within the 2-week period, you will be responsible for the entire stay, unless we can rent it out. There is no smoking or pets allowed in cabins.

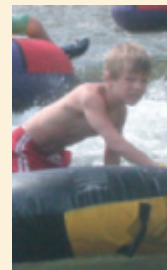
DINNER TRAIL RIDE

Cowboys & cowgirls must be 7 years of age to ride by themselves. **Weight limit: 275 lbs.**

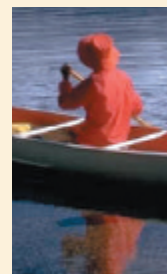
RIVER TUBING

CAMPGROUND POLICIES

Good camping practices and consideration for your neighbor will make your stay more enjoyable. We would like to call your attention to these rules.

SPEED LIMIT 5 mph throughout the campground.

Watch for children.

QUIET TIME Must be observed from 11:00 pm to 8:00 am.

All radios must be turned off between these hours. Minors must be at their campsites during these hours. During the day, please keep music at a reasonable level.

NO 4-WHEELERS OR FIREWORKS ALLOWED.

NO BIKE RIDING AFTER DARK

PETS must be on a leash, kept quiet, and cleaned up after. No pets are allowed in the rest rooms, playground area, or camp store.

CUTTING TREES of any kind is not allowed. We sell firewood at the office.

GARBAGE Please put your garbage in the dumpsters when you leave. Please help us keep your site clean.

REST ROOMS & SHOWERS are open 24 hours.
Showers are coin operated. No dish washing in the sinks.

RESPECT Please respect other camper's by not short cutting across their sites.

VEHICLES No more than 2 vehicles per site.

AGE LIMIT No one under 18 is allowed to camp without a parent or guardian.

We reserve the right to evict anyone, without a refund, who creates a disturbance, nuisance, or endangers the safety of other campers or guests.

We are not responsible for accidents or injury to our guests or for the loss of money or valuables of any kind.

There is **NO LIFEGUARD** on duty at the pool. You are responsible for the behavior and safety of your children in the "Pool Area". Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult. Children must be potty-trained to use pool or use a swimmer diaper.
